2. How can we make changes to personnel currently working at school?
 - a. Ms. Galiano will introduce out of the classroom staff at the next Coffee with the Principal. She will also send each out of the classroom personnel a description of their duties and remind them that their position was bought with funds that require them to interact with staff and families to best support student success.
3. Hire a math coach to help with low scores.
 - a. Yes, we would like to open and hire a math coach for the following year.
4. Volunteers help create posters at every entrance before ELAC, SSC, and Coffee with the Principal.
 - a. Yes, this would be great.
